



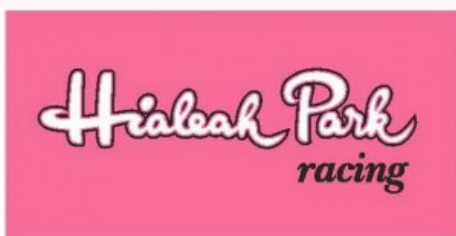
Hialeah Park American Quarter Horse Season Fast Facts For Horsemen



After an eight-year closure, historic Hialeah Park in South Florida reopened November 28 with American Quarter Horses racing for 40 days. The success of American Quarter Horses at Hialeah Park is of national racing significance and your help is needed. Bring your racing American Quarter Horses to Hialeah and help ensure the track's success and that of American Quarter Horse racing in North America!

- November 28 – February 2
- 10 weeks of racing; four days each week; 40 days total
- Saturday – Tuesday racing schedule
- First race post time 2:05 p.m.
- Entries taken **one week out**
- Average overnight purse - **\$9,500** (*all starters earn at least 2% of overnight purses meaning a minimum of \$100 to 10th*)
- Average daily purses - **\$100,000**
- With average fields near seven horses per race, multiple opportunities exist to enter and run – no horses excluded at this point
- Excellent stall accommodations
- RV slots available (\$250/month including utilities, all 20' x 30')
- Extended-stay apartments and living facilities available nearby
- Workers' compensation insurance for existing employees accepted; Companies available at Hialeah writing reasonable policies for new hires in Florida
- Experienced horsemen's representative – Duayne Didericksen – on-site for horsemen
- Average sunny temperatures near 70 degrees
