Applicant must enclose appropriate fees: \$50.00 for WEANLINGS (by August 31 of weanling year); \$75.00 between September 1 and December 31 of weanling year; \$200 for YEARLINGS (up to December 31 of yearling year), and \$300 TWO-YEAR OLDS AND OLDER (Beginning January 1 of 2 year old year). Non Members of FQHRA add \$50.00 to all fees. No horse shall be eligible for Florida-Bred premiums or to accrue points towards Florida-Bred awards until fully accredited by completion of proper application and payment of appropriate fees. Florida Bred awards under this program are for racing performance only.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the above foal is a Florida-Bred as described in the rules for Accreditation of Florida-Bred Quarter Horse Foals and Regulations for Administration of the Florida-Bred Quarter Horse Program. I assume full responsibility for the registration of the horse as a Florida-Bred and agree that if the horse is later proved to be ineligible due to registration based upon false or fraudulent information, (1) the horse shall no longer be considered a Florida-Bred, (2) I will be forever denied the privilege of registering any animals as Florida-Bred, and (3) I will be forever denied the benefit of any and all breeders' awards in Florida.

RULES FOR ACCREDITATION OF FLORIDA-BRED QUARTER HORSE FOALS

- A. Effective January 1, 2010; a Florida-Bred is defined as follows:
1. A mare domiciled in Florida has to breed to an Accredited Florida Stallion at least once every other year for her foals to be eligible for Accredited Florida Bred status.
 2. Pregnant mares that foal in Florida for the first time have to breed back that same year to an Accredited Florida Stallion in order for their first Florida foal to be eligible for Accredited Florida Bred status.
 3. All foals born in Florida are eligible for Accredited Florida Bred status as long as the mare breeds back to an Accredited Florida Stallion at least once every other year and follow rules 1 & 2 above.
 4. All foals born attaining Accredited Florida Bred status by being born in the state of Florida are subject to having the birth verified by a designated FQHRA official within 24 hours of the birth. Failure to notify FQHRA within 24 hours of the in-state birth may result in the foal not being an eligible Accredited Florida bred. ALL OUT OF STATE (non Florida residents) OWNERS AND BREEDERS MUST have a photo taken within 24 hours of birth that shows the foal and a permanent stationary object that can substantiate that the foal's birth occurred in Florida. (Examples include: barn, house, etc.) OR they can provide official licensed veterinary records documenting that the foal was born in Florida and seen by a licensed veterinarian within 24 hours of birth.
 5. All foals by accredited Florida stallions are accredited Florida bred eligible no matter where they are born.
 6. There is no limit on the number of Accredited Florida Bred eligible embryos a mare may produce in one year as long as the mare meets the requirement of breeding to at least one Accredited Florida Stallion every other year.
 7. No clones are eligible for Accredited Florida Bred status.
 8. To be eligible for Accredited Florida Bred status beginning January 1, 2010, a horse must meet the above requirements, fill out the Accredited Florida Bred application and pay the appropriate fees.
- B. In order to have a foal accredited as a Florida-Bred, the following rules are to be followed:
1. **READ** the above **RULES FOR ACCREDITATION** of Florida-Bred foals carefully.
 2. A correct and completely filled out **APPLICATION FOR ACCREDITATION** must be sent to the Florida Quarter Horse Racing Association. The burden for the correctness and authenticity of all information supplied on the application is borne by the applicant. Forms are available upon request from this office. **PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT** all information and **DOUBLE CHECK** the application for accuracy.
 3. The breeder of a horse shall be the breeder named on the official American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) registration certificate.
 4. **A copy of the horse's registration certificate issued by the American Quarter Horse Association, must accompany this application.** The Department of Agriculture will issue a certificate, bearing the Florida-Bred identification number. If the horse's registration certificate has not yet been received from AQHA, this office will hold the application pending receipt of a copy of the registration certificate.
 5. FEES: Enclose proper registration fee. Make check payable to FQHRA. Non members of FQHRA add \$50.00 to all fees.

WEANLINGS – until December 31	\$ 75.00
YEARLINGS (up to December 31 of yearling year)	\$ 200.00
TWO-YEAR OLDS + (beginning January 1 of 2 yr old year)	\$ 300.00
